



What's in my tray?

Phonics



<u> Phonics- Phase 2-</u>

<u>'k' – k, k, kind</u>

<u>What you will need:</u>

- Gratnells F1 Shallow Tray
- Downloadable tray label
- Coloured card/paper
- Pen

What to do: (Teacher/Teaching Assistant)

- 1. Label the tray using the downloadable label.
- 2. Draw and cut round circles.
- 3. Add a smiley face to the circle.
- 4. On the back of the face write a word with the 'k' grapheme.

What to do: (child)

- 1. Ask the child to pick any smiley face.
- 2. They have to carefully segment and blend the sounds in the word to read it correctly.
- 3. Encourage them to say 'k, k, kind' as they are reading to check the pronunciation of the sound.
- 4. When the word has been read, they have to think of someone who has been kind to them and draw a picture of their face on the back of the circle. (PSHE links)

Differentiation:

<u>Easier:</u>

Practise forming the letter 'k'.

<u>Harder:</u>

Can you think of three more words with the 'k' grapheme?
