





<u>'oa'- oa, oa, boat</u>



What you will need:

- Gratnells F1 Shallow Tray •
- Downloadable tray label •
- Toy boats
- Pen
- Water to fill tray

What to do: (Teacher/Teaching Assistant)

- 1. Label the tray using the downloadable label.
- 2. Fill the tray with water
- 3. Write the words onto the sails.
- 4. Place the boats in the tray.

What to do: (child)

- 1. Ask the child to read as many 'oa' words as they can.
- 2. Pick a boat from the water and read the word on it.
- 3. Encourage them to say 'oa, oa, boat' as they are reading to check the pronunciation of the sound.

Differentiation:

Easier:

Get a piece of paper. Dip finger into the water and practise forming the 'oa' phoneme on the paper.

Harder:

Can you write a sentence with one of the words?
