What's in my tray?

Phonics

Phonics- Phase 3- 'ng'- ng, ng, ring



What you will need:

- Gratnells F1 Shallow Tray
- Downloadable tray label
- Cardboard tubes
- Coloured card
- Sellotape
- Pen
- Scissors

What to do: (Teacher/Teaching Assistant)

1. Label the tray using the downloadable label.
2. Cut the cardboard tubes in strips at the bottom so they can be stuck to the base.
3. Write the points score on each tube.
4. Cut out rings from the coloured card and write on words with the 'ng' sound.
5. Stick the tubes onto the base of the tray and place the rings to one side.

What to do: (child)

1. Ask the child to read as many 'ng' words as they can.
2. Pick a ring and read the word on it.
3. Encourage them to say 'ng, ng, ring' as they are reading to check the pronunciation of the sound.
4. After it has been read, throw the ring to land on one of the tubes to get the points.

Differentiation:

Easier:

Try with three rings to develop recognition and decoding of the sound.

Harder:

On the back of a ring, write a sentence with one of the 'ng' words in it.
