Phonics- Phase 3-

<u>'er'- er, er, germ</u>



What you will need:

- Gratnells F1 Shallow Tray
- Downloadable tray label
- Downloadable germ images
- Small toy bins (or use coloured pots instead)
- Scissors

What to do: (Teacher/Teaching Assistant)

- 1. Label the tray using the downloadable label.
- 2. Download, print and cut out the germ words.
- 3. Place the words into the tray.
- 4. Place the toy bins/pots into the tray.

What to do: (child)

- 1. Ask the child to read as many words as they can.
- 2. Child to pick a word to read.
- 3. Encourage them to say 'er, er, germ' as they are reading to check the pronunciation of the sound.
- 4. After the word has been read, it has to be put into the correct colour bin.

Differentiation:
Easier:
Focus on four words (one of each colour).
<u>Harder:</u>
What other phonemes also make the 'er' sound?
