'aw'- aw, aw, draw



Phonics- Phase 3-

<u>'aw - aw, aw, draw</u>



What you will need:

- Gratnells F1 Shallow Tray
- Downloadable tray label
- Black sugar paper
- Chalk

What to do: (Teacher/Teaching Assistant)

- 1. Label the tray using the downloadable label
- 2. Cut the black sugar paper to fit the base of the tray.
- 3. Place the paper inside.
- 4. Write the 'aw' words using the chalk and leave space next to each word.

What to do: (child)

- 1. Ask the child to read as many words as they can.
- 2. Find a word to read.
- 3. Read the word. Encourage them to say 'aw, aw, draw' as they are reading to check the pronunciation of the sound.
- 4. After they have read the word, they now need to draw a picture to match the word using the chalk.

Differentiation:

Easier:

Which letters make the 'aw' sound?

Harder:

Can you use two words in a written sentence?
