Phonics-Phase 3-

'ay - ay, ay, play



What you will need:

- Gratnells F1 Shallow Tray
- Downloadable tray label
- Card pieces to write words on
- Pen
- Die
- Counters
- Blu-tack

What to do: (Teacher/Teaching Assistant)

- 1. Label the tray using the downloadable label
- 2. Write out the words onto the pieces of card.
- 3. Blu-tack the words onto the base of the tray in any pattern you wish.
- 4. Place the die and counters in the tray.

What to do: (child)

- 1. Ask the child to read as many words as they can.
- 2. Roll the die and move the counter that number of spaces.
- 3. Read the word. Encourage them to say 'ay, ay, play' as they are reading to check the pronunciation of the sound.
- 4. After they have read the word, it's their partners turn. Who will get to the finish line first?

Differentiation:

Easier:

Remove the element of playing against someone else. Focus on reading simple words.

Harder:

Can you read all the words in the tray?
