## Phonics-Phase 3-

'ew' - ew, ew, flew



### What you will need:

- Gratnells F1 Shallow Tray
- Downloadable tray label
- x2 Pieces of white paper
- Pen

#### What to do: (Teacher/Teaching Assistant)

- 1. Label the tray using the downloadable label
- 2. Write 'Landing zone' onto piece of paper and place inside the tray.
- 3. Get another piece of paper and make a plane.
- 4. Write words that have the 'ew' phoneme onto the plane.
- 5. Place the plane into the tray.

#### What to do: (child)

- 1. Ask the child to read as many words as they can that are on the plane.
- 2. Read the word.
- 3. Encourage them to say 'ew, ew, flew' as they are reading to check the pronunciation of the
- 4. After they have read the word, can they throw the plane to land in the tray?

#### **Differentiation:**

#### Easier:

Write a couple of words onto the paper plane.

#### Harder:

Read all the words on the plane.

Move back to make it harder to land in the tray.
