Phonics-Phase 3-

'ey' - ey, ey, key



What you will need:

- Gratnells F1 Shallow Tray
- Downloadable tray label
- Downloadable key images
- Scissors
- Blu-tack

What to do: (Teacher/Teaching Assistant)

- 1. Label the tray using the downloadable label
- 2. Download, print and cut the key images out.
- 3. Blu-tack the keys on to the base of the tray in a path to reach the finish padlock.
- 4. Draw arrows on the tray to guide the student of the direction to take.

What to do: (child)

- 1. Ask the child to read as many words as they can that are on the keys.
- 2. Read the word.
- 3. Encourage them to say 'ey, ey, key' as they are reading to check the pronunciation of the sound.
- 4. Can they read all the words to get to the final key and unlock the padlock?

Differentiation:

Easier:

Add sound buttons.

Harder:

Remove the 'ey' from some of the words for the child to complete as they are reading the word.
