







Phonics- Phase 3-

'ie' - ie, ie, tie



What you will need:

- Gratnells F1 Shallow Tray •
- Downloadable tray label
- Downloadable tie image
- Whiteboard pen
- Scissors

What to do: (Teacher/Teaching Assistant)

- 1. Label the tray using the downloadable label
- 2. Draw the shirt collar onto the base of the tray
- 3. Download, print and cut out the tie images
- 4. Place the ties in the tray

What to do: (child)

- 1. Ask the child to read as many words as they can.
- 2. Pick a tie to read.
- 3. Encourage them to say 'ie, ie, tie' as they are reading to check the pronunciation of the sound.
- 4. After it has been read, attach it to the shirt collar. How many ties can they attach?

Differentiation:
<u>Easier:</u>
Add sound buttons to the ties.
<u>Harder:</u>
Can they use one of the words in a sentence?
