

## Phonics-Phase 3-

<u>'o\_e' - o\_e, o\_e, bone</u>



## What you will need:

- Gratnells F1 Shallow Tray
- Downloadable tray label
- · Downloadable bone image
- Scissors
- Sand to fill tray

### What to do: (Teacher/Teaching Assistant)

- 1. Label the tray using the downloadable label
- 2. Download, print and cut out the bones
- 3. Fill the tray with sand
- 4. Place the bones in the sand

### What to do: (child)

- 1. Ask the child to read as many words as they can.
- 2. Pick a bone and read the word.
- 3. Encourage them to say 'o\_e, o\_e, bone' as they are reading to check the pronunciation of the sound.

## **Differentiation:**

#### Easier:

Have a select few words hidden amongst the sand.

#### Harder:

Ask them to spell a couple of words with the o\_e split digraph.
