





What's in my tray?

Phonics





What you will need:

- Gratnells F1 Shallow Tray
- Downloadable tray label
- Masking tape
- 1 x piece of coloured card/paper
- 1 x die or rolling object (we used a foam square)

What to do: (Teacher/Teaching Assistant)

- 1. Label the tray using the downloadable label.
- 2. Make a grid using the masking tape.
- 3. Cut up the card into small squares and write down words with the 'ff' grapheme.
- 4. Place the cards into each space on the grid.

What to do: (child)

- 1. Ask the child to roll the die/foam square into the tray.
- 2. When the object has landed in a space, they have to carefully segment and blend the sounds in the word to read it correctly.
- 3. Encourage them to say 'ff, ff, huff, puff' as they are reading to check the pronunciation of the sound.
- 4. When the word has been read, roll again and keep reading!

Differentiation:

<u>Easier:</u>

Use robot arms to sound out each individual sound in a word. Focus on a couple of words.

<u>Harder:</u>

How many words can you read in 2 minutes?
